Home-baking...

Pancake Day is fast approaching! Here's a recipe taken from www.bbcgoodfood.com. How many times can you flip a pancake?!

You Will Need:

- 100g plain flour
- 2 large eggs
- 300ml milk
- 1 tbsp sunflower or vegetable oil, plus a little extra for frying



Method

1. Put 100g plain flour, 2 large eggs, 300ml milk, 1 tbsp sunflower or vegetable oil and a pinch of salt into a bowl or large jug, then whisk to a smooth batter.
2. Set aside for 30 mins to rest if you have time, or start cooking straight away.
3. Set a medium frying pan or crêpe pan over a medium heat and carefully wipe it with some oiled kitchen paper.
4. When hot, cook your pancakes for 1 min on each side until golden, keeping them warm in a low oven as you go.
5. Serve with lemon wedges and caster sugar, or your favourite filling.

Year 12 suggest trying fresh fruit, golden syrup or the classic sugar and lemon on your pancakes.

Did you know 5th February was World Nutella Day so why not spread that on your pancakes too!

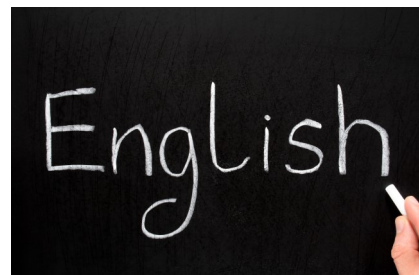

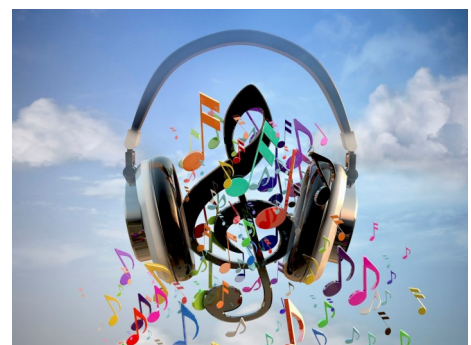

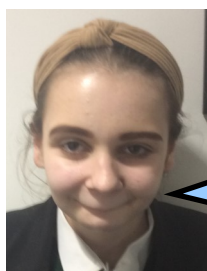

Charity of the Half Term...

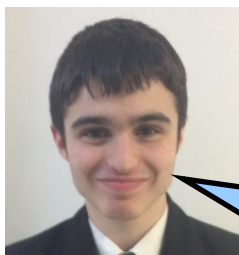

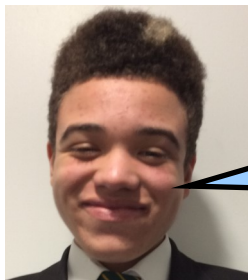
My favourite thing about Cheshire Buddies is going to Blackpool Sandcastle Waterpark!

Hippos!

Did you know February 15th is World Hippo Day? These huge mud-loving animals from Africa are sadly under threat. Learn more about these deadly mammals in this report...

Habitat

Hippos live in East Africa. Hippos live in a group from 10 to 30 hippos with just one male hippo. Hippos are very aggressive and can fight enemies by using their large teeth and tusks. They mark their territory by flinging poo everywhere. Hippos love water, and always found around rivers or lakes. Hippos can't breathe under water but they hold their breath and close their ears and noses tightly to keep the water out.

While common hippos prefer grasslands, pygmy hippos live mainly in forests.



Species

There are two types of hippos. There is a pygmy hippo which is smaller and the common hippos. In London zoo they have two pygmy hippos. Keeping hippos in zoos is one way to help them survive as a species. It keeps their numbers up, especially if they can breed and have babies.



Baby hippos are called calves. A baby hippo weighs about 100 pounds which weighs the same as a big dog.

Diet

Hippos are vegetarians and only eat plant food. Hippos have to eat a lot because they are big. Because they eat so much, they also poo, burp and trump a lot too!



Common hippos eat grass and other plants. Pygmy hippos set off in the evening, munch their way along the forest trails and return at round midnight. In forests and swamps where they live, there isn't much grass. They eat ferns, leaves, roots and young plant shoots.

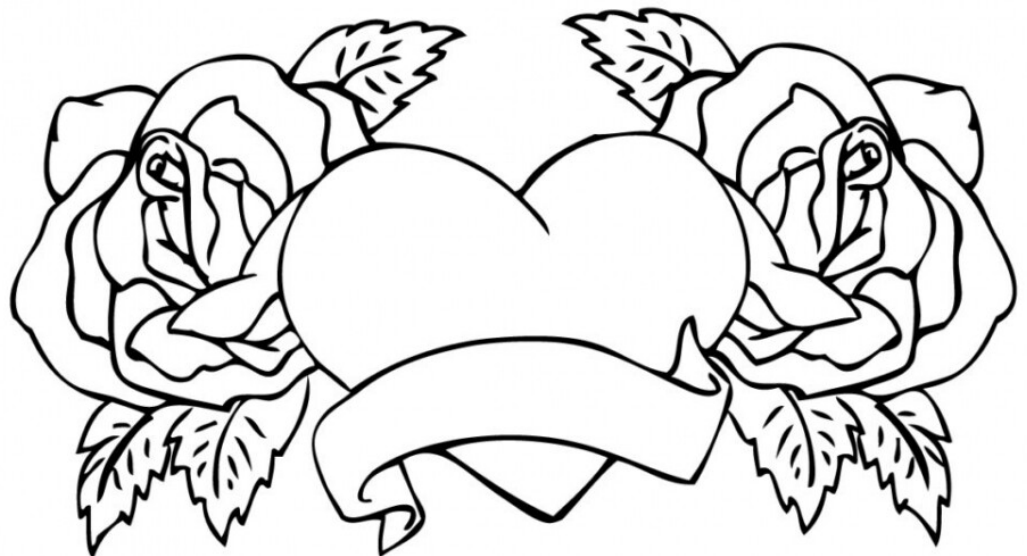

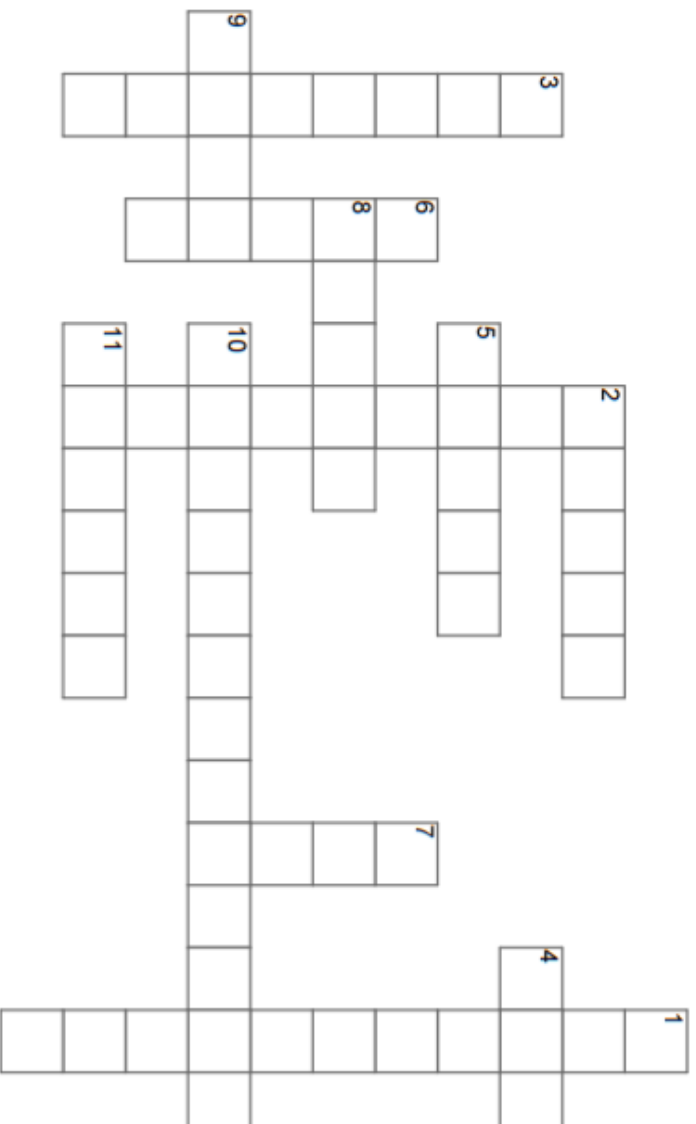

It seems to have been a loooooong winter this year even though we haven't had much snow. However, the evenings are getting longer as the sun sets later and the weather is slowly warming up.

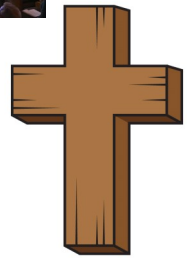
Signs that Spring is on its way always cheer us up and bring us hope of warmer days.
