RE: Theatre Workshop – Friday 20th January 2023

I am writing to inform you that your child will be participating in a theatre workshop as part of their RSHE curriculum this Friday. This workshop will involve watching a performance put on by 2engage and then participating in discussion around the content of the performance.

Your child will be watching a performance called 'SnapTrap' which focuses on a story about e-safety. A synopsis of this performance can be found below:

"The Snap Trap' is an interactive theatre show which helps children recognise the risks associated with online activity and the use of social media including apps such as: Snapchat, Instagram and WhatsApp. We tell the real stories of young people and how their digital lives turned their real lives upside-down. There are two central characters in the show who we see fall into dangerous situations online. Sam is being coerced into taking risks that are only going to end one way. Amy thinks she is meeting up with the coolest boy in school, but it turns out that she has been talking to someone completely different. Facilitators pause the action throughout the performance and encourage audiences to share their thoughts on the issues."

All topics are delivered in an age-appropriate and sensitive way. The performance is designed to help pupils understand how to stay safe online and why this is important. I would also encourage you to continue any conversations about this topic with your young person at home.
