RE: Theatre Workshop – Friday 20th January 2023

I am writing to inform you that your child will be participating in a theatre workshop as part of their RSHE curriculum this Friday. This workshop will involve watching a performance put on by Zengage and then participating in discussion around the content of the performance.

Your child will be watching a performance called 'Risking It All' which focuses on two stories about unsafe relationships. It follows the character Julie who is victim of grooming and support pupils to identify some important warning signs of inappropriate behaviours. It also follows the character of Ben which explores issues of risk, alcohol and substance misuse, grooming and criminal exploitation. The theatre workshop aims to support pupils by:

- Raising awareness of unhealthy relationships and sexual exploitation.
- Highlighting what unsafe online contact looks like in everyday life.
- Encouraging teenagers to identify the signs of criminal exploitation and grooming.
- Examining the risks of drug and alcohol misuse.
- Signposting support networks available.

All topics are delivered in an age-appropriate and sensitive way. The performance is designed to help pupils understand how to keep themselves safe in a variety of different situations and relationships. I would also encourage you to continue any conversations about these topics with your young person at home.
