

- Plan out your final piece of work
- Use mind maps or spider-grams to help you gather ideas
- This can be completed roughly in the back of your sketchbook to start with and add to it if your ideas change

- Develop your ideas from your findings
- How can you incorporate your link artist style into your work?
- Make the art work your own and individual

- Research and find images that link to your theme
- Carry out observational drawings
- Incorporate shade, tone, colour

ThinkDon't panic!!!

- Do you have an artist link for your theme/work?
- Carry out research and develop pieces of their work showing the techniques used
- Write about WHAT YOU THINK!

- Annotations are very important, use the list of sentence starters and key words to help you
- Discuss in your own words
- DO NOT copy text from the internet

- BE CREATIVE! THIS IS YOUR TIME TO SHINE!
- YOUR IDEAS CANNOT BE WRONG!

- What is the focal point of your work
- Continue to relate it to your chosen title
- What materials are you going to
