

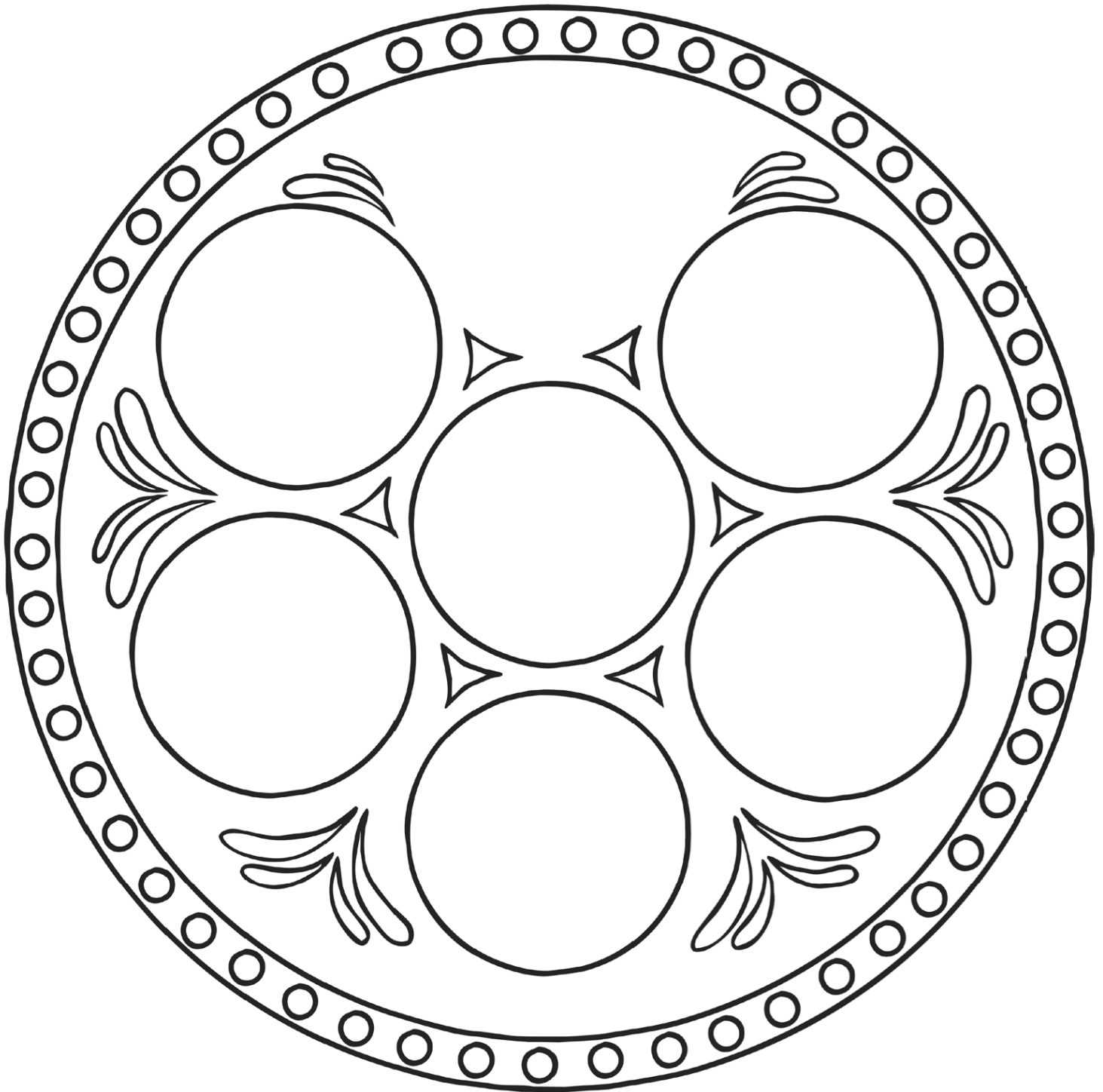


Seder Plate
