Year 7	Curriculum and Key Words
Autumn Term 1	<b>Weather</b> Rain, clouds, thunderstorm, lightening, temperature, forecast, symbols, collect data and put into graphs.
Autumn Term 2	<b>Climate</b> Temperate, polar, arctic, tropical, desert, features and effects of various climates. Read and interpret graphs.
Spring Term 1	<b>Volcanoes and Earthquakes.</b> Features, earth's crust, eruptions, where located, tectonic plates – divergent, convergent, transform, ring of fire.
Spring Term 2	<b>Developing country (Kenya)</b> Rich, poor, developing, standard of living
Summer Term 1	<b>Where I live</b> Map skills, ordnance survey, reading scales, reading street maps, perceptions of place.
Summer Term 2	<b>Map skills</b> Ordnance survey, map reading, visit, data collection, construction of graphs.
