Dear Parents/Carers

Year 11 and Year 12 - Important Information regarding Planned Provision 28th June – 16th July 2021

As stated in a previous letter we have decided to offer a full years school provision to year 11 and 12 students this year, meaning pupils will have the opportunity and choice to continue to attend school beyond the last Friday in June (25th) which is their official leaving date, up until Friday 16th July.

To ensure we provide a rewarding and enriching curriculum during this time we have teamed up with the National Citizen Service (NCS) to plan an engaging programme for them to enjoy. A part of this curriculum included a week long residential which some of you had signed your child up for. Unfortunately we have had to reluctantly make the decision to cancel the residential part of the programme on the week commencing 28th June due to restrictions in place by the National and Local government regarding young people staying overnight. We will however still be working alongside the NCS for the other two weeks of the programme which will involve a range of exciting and enriching activities, hopefully both in and out of school, dependent on the Covid-19 restrictions that will be in place. Further details of this programme/curriculum will be sent out closer to the time once we can confirm what the offer will be, dependent on any Covid-19 restrictions that will be in place.

Please note - Pupils will not be able to attend school and will therefore need to stay at home on Thursday 1st July and Friday 2nd July. This is due to year 6 transition days and the staffing required to facilitate these days.

The Prom

We are excited to announce that we will be holding an end of year prom on Thursday 1st July at 7.00pm - 9.30pm for year 11 and 12 (as long as Covid-19 restrictions allow). After what has been a very challenging year, we want to congratulate them on their hard work, dedication and the resilience that they have shown and we are really looking forward to celebrating their time with us and giving them the send-off they deserve. The prom will take place at Oaklands School and full details will be sent out closer to the time.

Students that wish to only attend prom and not the full range of activities are free to do so.

If you wish to discuss any aspects of the end of year offer please do not hesitate to contact school. It is also to be noted that during these final 3 weeks, year 11 and 12 will become a year group bubble together so that all leavers can be included in the activities.
